



IREVA Tournament/Event Approval Status Definitions

Approved: All Type of Events that are not a Tournament will have an approval status of Approved.

Approved – Developmental: A developmental tournament is to provide low cost, entry level opportunities for junior players/teams/clubs that may need such a transition into our current competitive tournament structure. Such tournaments can be requested at any time during the season and should be noted on the Tournament/Event Request form. All policies and procedures are in place with the exception of:

- a. uniforms are not required;
- b. One Official will be assigned, typically one-per gym, to supervise and assist only; teams must provide a “qualified” work team including a R1,
- c. Allowed additional time outs, 1 per every 5 points, with coaches on the court for instructional purposes.
- d. Full details on Developmental Events will be posted soon!

Approved – Friendship: Friendship tournaments are sanctioned from September 1st – December 31st (pre-season) and Regionals through October 31st (post-season).

- e. Uniforms and official scorekeeping are not required. All regular in season rules, policies, and procedures must be followed; however, results will not count toward standings. Teams must provide a capable R1, R2, visual scorer and 2 lines people. Webpoint rosters are required. Paid officials may be available upon if requested by the Tournament Director on the Tournament/Event Request form for the event sanctioning.

Approved - Non-Traditional: Non-Traditional tournaments are sanctioned from January 1st through Regional Championships for BOD approved extenuating circumstances only.

- f. All regular season rules, policies, and procedures (including uniforms and official scorekeeping) are required. Webpoint rosters are required. Since the Region will be unable to supply paid officials for the event, teams must provide a capable R1, certified R2 and scorer, as well as, a libero tracker, visual scorer and 2 lines people.

Approved – Traditional: Traditional tournaments are sanctioned from January 1st through Regional Championships and if requested by the TD, after Regional Championships through October 31st.

- g. All regular season rules, policies and procedures including uniforms and official scorer are required. Webpoint rosters are required. Paid officials will be assigned by the Region. Teams must provide a certified R2 and scorer-as well as a libero tracker, visual scorer and 2 lines people.
