

IREVA uniforms policy - 2006/07

A reminder to all players, team reps and club directors: the following policy concerning uniforms was adopted by IREVA's Board of Directors in 2006 and enforced for the 2006 Regional Championships; this policy will continue to be enforced throughout the 2006/07 season.

- JERSEYS
 - The color and design for the jersey must be uniform for the team (except for the libero).
 - All shirts must be numbered from 1-99 (**Taped numbers will not be accepted**).
 - The numbers must be of a uniform color that is contrasting with the jersey.
 - Sleeve lengths are not required to be identical, per rulebook.
 - **HOWEVER, TANK TOPS CANNOT BE MIXED WITH SHORT SLEEVE OR LONG SLEEVE SHIRTS.**
- SHORTS
 - The color and design for shorts must be **similar** in style and color (excluding a small manufacturer's logo). Some examples to follow:
 - Shorts with stripes are not similar to shorts without stripes.
 - Shorts with a wide stripe are not similar to shorts with a narrow stripe.
 - Spandex is not similar to baggies.
 - Board shorts are not similar to short shorts.
 - **BLACK IS NOT SIMILAR TO NAVY BLUE.**
- LIBERO
 - The Libero player must wear a uniform whose jersey at least must contrast in color with that of the other members of the team.
 - The Libero uniform may have a different design but it must be numbered like the rest of the team members.

In addition, regarding uniform numbers, please keep in mind that USAV has published the following future rule change -

Until Nov 1, 2007 - For the front, the number must be either centered or the top of the number must be no more than 12.5 cm (5") down from the shoulder seam. The medial edge of the number must be no more than 7.5 cm (3") from the midline of the jersey. [In other words, the number can be either centered or in one of the top corners.]

After Nov 1, 2007 - Uniform numbers must be centered on the chest and on the back. **[If you are getting new uniforms that you plan on having for a while, it is suggested to center the numbers.]**

Both now and in the future, the numbers must be a minimum of 10 cm (4") in height on the chest and a minimum of 15 cm (6") in height on the back. It [is recommended that the numbers be a minimum of 15 cm (6") in height on the chest and a minimum of 20 cm (8") on the back.
