



IREVA JUNIORS DEVELOPMENTAL EVENTS – 2010/11

1. GOALS

- a. Provide low cost, entry level opportunities for younger players and new players.
- b. Evaluate these events as a pilot for cost reduction, attracting new clubs / members, use of player-officials, etc.

2. FORMAT

- a. Events in this category are to uniformly comply with all policies listed here, unless exceptions are explicitly approved.
- b. These events are to be sanctioned, scheduled and advertised as “developmental tournaments” or another name that will clearly distinguish them as a second tier vs. regular events.
- c. TDs are required to use AES for entries and results; players do not need to be identified in AES.
- d. Conglomerate [inter-club] teams allowed; results do not count for standings / seedings.
- e. Age and gender constraints policies are applicable.
- f. All requirements for membership, background checks, IMPACT, WEBPOINT rosters and submission of results are applicable.

3. EVENT CONDUCT / CHANGES FROM REGULAR EVENTS

- a. Uniforms are not required, but encouraged.
- b. Scoresheets are required in order to document the match results; complete scoresheet detail is not required but encouraged.
- c. A Head Official will be assigned, typically one-per gym; the HO is only to supervise and assist; teams must provide a “qualified” work team including R1.
- d. Additional time-outs: 1 per 5 points per set
- e. Coaches are allowed to briefly enter the court for instructional purposes.
